

Admission Test Requirements

Students Applying for Grades 9–12

Bradford Christian Academy accepts the SSAT (Secondary School Admissions Test) to fulfill the admission test requirement. We also accept the High School Placement Test (HSPT).

SSAT testing dates and locations (all Saturdays) are on the SSAT website, <u>www.ssat.org</u>, including international locations.

We recommend that every applicant taking the SSAT complete the sample practice test online at <u>www.ssat.org</u>. It will familiarize the student with the test format and questions similar to those on the SSAT. Practice books which include two full-length practice tests are available on the website.

International Students must submit SLEP or TOEFL test results in addition to the admission test results.

Students Applying for Grades 5–8

U.S. Students: After receiving the application and fee a BCA representative will contact the applicant to register the student for a test date. An interview will be scheduled when the application and testing are completed.
