



Hasseltine Scholarship Process and Instructions

Bradford Christian Academy welcomes your application. Please read the following steps carefully before returning the completed scholarship application. To be considered for the Hasseltine scholarship the complete application, question responses, and teacher nomination/recommendation must be completed and submitted to Ms. Thurston at the time of application or before May 1, 2017. You will receive an email from BCA acknowledging receipt of the application.

Qualifications:

- ❖ Student must be currently enrolled in their sophomore or junior year at BCA
- ❖ Student must be in good standing academically
- ❖ Student must complete the following to submit a complete application:
 - **Hasseltine Scholarship Application Form** (below).
 - **Responses to Questions** - Students respond to the three questions on a separate piece of paper (preferably typed). Questions are included on the Hasseltine Scholarship Application Form.
 - **Nomination/Recommendation** - Students must request a nomination from a BCA high school teacher. The nomination should be submitted in the form of a recommendation letter. This letter should address the maturity and leadership of the applicant and how his is demonstrated at BCA or in the teacher's experience/observation. This letter must be submitted by May 15th, 2016 for the applicant to be considered for this scholarship.

The application and nomination letter must be complete and submitted to Ms. Thurston by May 1, 2017 to be considered for this scholarship. Forms may be submitted electronically or paper form in the following ways:
