

High School Performing Arts Teacher

Bradford Christian Academy is accepting applications for a part-time, high-school Performing Arts teacher for the 2020-2021 academic school year. Applicants must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with experience in Performing Arts, two or more years teaching experience, and agree with Bradford Christian Academy's statement of faith. Teacher certification and a master's degree are preferred. Candidates must

1. Demonstrate the ability to teach students with integrity, enthusiasm, and skill,
2. Pursue excellence as an educator, embracing opportunities for improvement and growth,
3. Set high standards, seek excellence, and coach students to success,
4. Enjoy working with high school students and middle school students,
5. Integrate the Christian world view with the subject matter,
6. Collaborate with the BCA teaching community, working to grow and strengthen the school,
7. Represent BCA in a positive light in all spheres of influence, and
8. Subscribe to standards for Christian living and be members in good standing at a Protestant, Catholic, or Orthodox church.

JOB RESPONSIBILITY

- Teach and supervise Lower School Theatre Club two days per week after school during the fall semester.
- Teach Intermediate/Advance Acting, two classes per week during the fall semester to high school students, including higher-level theatre skills and transition work for the Massachusetts Educational Theatre Guild (METG).
- Teach Introduction to Acting, two classes per week during the spring semester to high school students, working on basic acting and communication skills, improv games, and short scene work.
- METG: Oversee all aspects of the competition play for METG High School Festival, including casting, directing, sets, costumes, sound, light, and communications with parents and the community. Attend all directors' meetings and maintain all required paper work for copywrites and guild membership.
- Spring Musical: strategically choose the musical to best highlight the talents and interests of the students and the values of the BCA community. License the play through MTI or other agencies. Oversee all aspects of the musical, including casting, directing, sets, costumes, sound, light, programs, and communications with parents and the community. Coordinate with Music Director, Choreographer, and parent volunteers.
- Coordinated the Christmas and Spring Concerts with the Music and Band Directors. Create the program, and host the event.
- Coordinate, support, and encourage other performing arts events, such as the Christmas Chapel, the Gala, the Coffee House, Baccalaureate, and Graduation.
